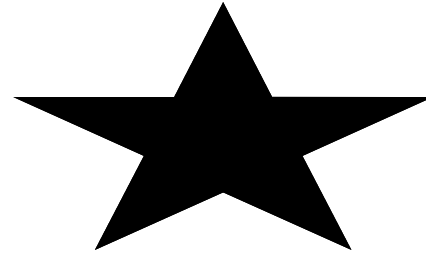
Cancellation Policy
